

2020-2021 ECN REMOTE LEARNING GUIDELINES

(Computer pick-up for remote learning will be on Monday, August 10, 2020 at 3:00 pm by the north, big gym doors)

Kindergarten through Fifth Grade

1. Attendance will be required for every virtual meeting (Zoom, Google Meets)
 - a. If a student does not attend any virtual meetings during a five day span and multiple contacts have been made by the teacher and administration with no student or parental response, the student will then be considered truant and the Regional Office of Education #47 will be notified.
2. Weekly Lessons and Assignments
 - a. Mrs. Sands (K-2), Mrs. Hippen (3-5), and Ms. Royer (Resource) will be contacting students and parents about weekly learning plans and assignments to be completed
 - b. Weekly assignments and plans will follow what is taking place during in-person instruction.
 - c. Homework will need to be completed on time. There could be a possibility of paper assignments. Assignment pick-up and drop-offs will be on Fridays at 3:00 p.m. at the main office.
3. Fall, Winter, and Spring Benchmarking
 - a. Remote students will be required to come to the building to complete reading and math testing three times during the school year. This will take place in the big gym, where no one will be in during the school day. Students will need to complete their testing in FastBridge and NWEA/MAP to determine their progress in math and reading. The student data will be used to determine placement for the following school year if students complete remote learning for the entire school year.
4. Competency Final Exam
 - a. If students complete remote learning for the whole school year, they will need to pass a competency exam at the end of the year to determine placement for next school year. If a student fails the exam, a team meeting will be held and retention will be discussed.

Sixth Grade through Eighth Grade

1. Attendance will be required for every virtual meeting (Zoom, Google Meets)

- a. If a student does not attend any virtual meeting during a five day span and multiple contacts have been made by the teacher and administration with no student or parental response, the student will then be considered truant and the Regional Office of Education #47 will be notified.
2. Weekly Lessons and Assignments
 - a. Mr. Chavira (Social Studies), Ms. Williams (Reading/ELA), Mr. McDowell (Math), Mrs. Gallentine (Science), and Ms. Zuidema (Resource) will be contacting students and parents about weekly learning plans and assignments to be completed.
 - b. Weekly assignments and plans will follow the same as in-person instruction.
 - c. Homework will need to be completed on time. There could be a possibility of paper assignments. Assignment pick-up and drop-offs will be on Fridays at 3:00 p.m. at the main office.
3. Fall, Winter, and Spring Benchmarking
